



## Kumi, Muhabura, and South Rwenzori Dioceses 'Rooted in Jesus'

Rooted in Jesus is a discipleship course written specifically for use in Africa. It first came to Kumi Diocese in 2006, then to South Rwenzori Diocese in 2008, and to Muhabura Diocese in 2009. Originally piloted in 2002 in Tanzania, Rooted in Jesus is currently in use in 41 dioceses or denominations in 14 countries in Africa, where it has been translated into 28 languages.

Archdeacon Japheth from South Rwenzori Diocese said, "I thank God for Rooted in Jesus because Christians' spiritual lifestyles have been revived through that method of 'Get rooted in Christ.'"

One Rooted in Jesus group member had been a Muslim. He said, "I didn't know who Jesus was, but now I do. I'm telling all my family and friends that Jesus is the right way."



Rooted in Jesus is a practical and interactive course. Each group member actively participates during the course and only the group leader needs to be able

to read and write. Each lesson is summarised by a memory verse, and members receive certificates when the group completes each of the four books of the course.
